Email confirmations will be sent to those providing a legible email address on their entry form. If you would like to receive your entry status by USPS prior to the issuance of the preliminary judging schedule at closing, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope or postcard along with your entry.

- Only one dog per entry form, include AKC titles only.
- All entries must be original copies submitted on official AKC Agility Entry Forms (attached) and must include an attached signed AKC agreement. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are **NOT** acceptable and will not be entered into the trial (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 4).
- Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted.
- Entries received within 24 hours of the opening date and time must: 1) include postage or be metered; and 2) be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier services, including, but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS, and DHL. Please waive signature requirements on all forms of delivery. Mail requiring signatures will be returned to the sender.
- A maximum of ten (10) entries per envelope are allowed. Envelopes with more than ten (10) entries and/or entries received prior to the opening date will be returned.
- No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Trial Secretary prior to the closing date and hour for entries.

- Make checks out to Platte Valley Kennel Club (PVKC).
- A returned check charge of \$35 will be leveled.
- Move ups (prior to trials) will be accepted until **September 16th, 2022** at 5 pm CT
- Day to day move ups will be accepted and must be provided to the Trial Secretary in writing at the trial site not later than the day preceding the event.

Online AKC Entry

This trial is accepting online entries through LabTestedOnline.com. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated online or paper will be as follows: 175 runs online (50%), 175 runs paper (50%) each day. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either. Mixed class/height entries may require paper entry to avoid overpayment.

Wait List for Withdrawn Entries After Closing Date/Time

A wait list will be kept until Monday, September 26th, 2022 to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 30 entries for each day will be placed on the wait list. Any entries received by the closing date/time that are withdrawn before the wait list deadline will be replaced by a wait listed entry, if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait list entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. If an entry is cancelled, but cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the trials. Any wait list entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by the wait list close date will receive a full refund.

Ribbons and Awards

Ribbons will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

 $\begin{array}{ll} \mbox{First Place} - \mbox{Blue} & \mbox{Second Place} - \mbox{Red} \\ \mbox{Third Place} - \mbox{Yellow} & \mbox{Fourth Place} - \mbox{White} \\ \end{array}$

Qualifying Score - Dark Green

A new title ribbon will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. A MACH or PACH rosette and decorated MACH or PACH bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that achieve their MACH or PACH. Double and Triple Q and HIT rosettes will be awarded.

Junior Ribbons and Awards

In addition to any regular placements, Juniors will be awarded 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th places for each class for qualifying runs.

4H Ribbons and Awards: Special Friday "Tricky Agility"

Any 4H youth completing a qualifying run will be awarded a special 4H ribbon.

From the West: I-80 Exit #442 - I-80 at Giles Road/ Harrison St. Turn Left onto Giles Road. Proceed to Harrison Street (traffic light). Turn Right onto Harrison Street (traffic light). Proceed to 110th Street. Turn Right onto 110th Street (traffic light). Off the Wall Soccer is on the right, past the gas station & car wash. Overflow parking on the left at the ESU across the street.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Privileges (PAL/ILP), and AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Services (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate.

Obstacles and Ring Conditions

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place indoors, air-conditioned facility on soccer turf. Ring size will be 85' x 110'.

Course Walk-Throughs and Warm-Up Information

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. Only handlers entered in the class will be permitted on the course. Walkthroughs may be limited to 25 handlers. If multiple walkthroughs are required for a class, they will be back-to-back and there will be no 5 minute countdown clock.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training the dog.

Notice to Exhibitors

<u>Food:</u> Lunch will be provided to volunteers. Limited concessions may be available on site, and fast food restaurants are within a 1 mile of the **Trial Site.**

<u>Trial Site</u> will be available after 7:00 AM Friday, Saturday and Sunday. This trial will be held indoors on soccer turf. Bring chairs, crates, and clean-up tools. Dogs must be removed from the trial site each day upon completion of the trial. <u>Indoor crating space</u> is available but separated from the agility ring. No ex-pens

will be permitted inside the building. **Crate mats or tarps are required under crates**.

Rules Changes: For Exhibition Only (FEO) entries in T2B and FAST and mixture of classes & jump heights is allowed at this trial per AKC change notice effective January 1, 2020. Fix and Go (FNG) is allowed. See AKC rules for details. FEO and FNG result in a non-qualifying score (NQ).

No food or beverages (except water) will be allowed on the soccer floor surface.

Refunds

- **Bitches in season will not be allowed to compete.** Entry fees less \$6.00 administrative fee and applicable AKC Recording fees per day (\$3 per run entered) will be refunded for bitches coming in season after the closing date. Owner must present certificate from veterinarian prior to start of show.
- **No refunds** will be given in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- If, because of riots or civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry will be made.
- Platte Valley Kennel Club reserves the right to cancel these trials in the event of extreme weather conditions and no entry fee refunds will be made in such case.

Special Junior/4H Only Class on Saturday Morning

Tricky Agility: All dogs can enter including those Junior /4H dogs not AKC registered. This will be a class with three levels and the course will be designed to run all entries together by jump height and course requirements. Dogs can enter level 3b (team/relay) as well as any other level.

Entrants may select their jump height regardless of the dog's AKC wither measurement. There are three jump heights: 8", 12" & 16". Dogs may run level 1 & 2 on leash at the choice of the handler. Entrants will run the sequence of obstacles and do tricks in designated areas and on the course. Each trick must be unique – i.e. tricks cannot be repeated. Tricks are defined as any AKC obedience, rally or trick dog requirement the handler chooses.

Level 3 may use optional agility obstacles as tricks. The table will be set at 8" or 16". Dogs over 18" will use the 16" table. All others will use the 8" table. The proper table height obstacle must be held for the AKC standard count of five. Time must be under the course time posted for the level. Scoring will be pass/fail – the sequence must be completed and no jump bars may fall.

The levels and requirements are:

- 1. 10 obstacles (bar jumps only, table and tunnels) and two tricks. 60 seconds.
- 2. 12 obstacles (jumps: bar, panel, double, broad and triple, table and tunnels) and three tricks. 60 seconds.
- 3. 16 obstacles (jumps: bar, panel, double, broad, tire and triple, table and tunnels) and four tricks. For this level, a teeter, weaves and an A-frame will be on the course for a trick option at the discretion of the handler. 75 seconds.
 - a. Run by one dog/handler team
 - b. Run by two dog/handler teams: For this option, the hand-off is the ½ way point. Each dog/handler team completes 8 obstacles and two tricks in sequence.

Safety, Behavior and Liability

- **By entering this trial**, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- The Platte Valley Kennel Club and AKC assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, injury, or death sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and assumes no responsibility for injury to children not under control of their parent(s) or guardian(s).
- Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. There will be no refunds of entry fees if a person is asked to leave the trial site.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times when not in the ring or in the designated warm-up area. La Vista requires all dogs to be on a leash or confined outdoors.
- Exhibitors are expected to comply with the La Vista's Disposal of Dog Waste Ordinance: Any person having custody or control of any dog shall have the responsibility of disposing of dog feces or manure of the dog in a sanitary manner.
- Crates may be left overnight; however, the Platte Valley Kennel Club and
 Off the Wall Soccer will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items
 left at the show site.
- Currently, masks are optional. At the time of the trial, if local regulations require it for Covid 19, masks could be required at all times on site except while running. A Covid waiver, below, may be required for entry.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. The City of La Vista requires Rabies Vaccinations.
- All dogs on site MUST belong to an entered competitor.

Ringside

- Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary
 or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for
 measuring prior to the start of their classes if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is
 available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be
 excused.
- **Judges are not required to wait for dogs**. Exhibitors alone are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
