VOLUNTEER SIGN UP: The volunteer signup sheet may be found by clicking [here](#), or by going to DoRightSecretary.com and clicking on Volunteer Signup heading at the trial site.

VMO: The judge IS a VMO. If your dog needs to be measured, you must be measured by the judge at this trial. Please arrive with enough time prior to your first run of the trial to have your dog measured. The judge will have the official measurement forms that you should fill out before being measured. Be prepared with your dogs AKC name, AKC registration number, and breeder information to put on the form.

FINAL RUN ORDER: The final run order will be constructed after move ups close on Monday April 13, 2026 at 6:00 pm. The final run order will be posted on DoRightSecretary.com under the Running Order heading.

MAPS: Printed maps will not be provided at the trial. The maps will be posted on Agility Gate each day and on DoRightSecretary.com. Printed copies will be posted in the main building at All Star Dog Sports and in the crating Annex.

In addition to using the Agility Gate app, the run order will be displayed each day at the trial on an iPad in the room where the practice jump is located, to make the running order available to all exhibitors. If you are unable to check in via the Agility Gate app, any exhibitor with the app can check you in, you may use the iPad in the practice jump room, or you can request that the Gate Steward check you in.

▶ ANNEX CRATING:

Please be aware we are adopting new crating rules in place for the Annex in an attempt to alleviate some of the problems with space and **due to the addition of new flooring**.

- No one will be allowed to set up in the Annex the day or evening prior to the trial except the Cleaning Angels that are cleaning the building on Sunday, if they are running a dog in the trial.
- Exhibitors will not be allowed to save space for other exhibitors.
- The Trial Committee will have space reserved and should have access to the Annex first.
- Crates and chairs in the annex that are not directly on the concrete must have a protective mat underneath to protect the flooring in the annex. The protective mat must be fully under your crate and chair. Please do not take up any additional space with your mat. There is a \$10 fine for spills and accidents on the new flooring surface. If you spill something or have an accident, please put your \$10 in the red money box in the main entryway to the right of the office.
- Unentered dogs must be in crates that are stacked. We understand people have reasons they need to bring unentered dogs, but either stack the crates or crate the dogs together.
- Chairs must be placed in front of crates. Please bring reasonably-sized chairs.
- A crating diagram for the annex is included with this document for your convenience.

Cooperation from exhibitors is appreciated in this matter.

SITE INFORMATION

- **BUILDING**: The building is climate controlled; indoor restrooms.
- **BUILDING SET-UP INFORMATION**: **THE BUILDING WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE FOR GENERAL SET-UP ON THURSDAY.** The building will open at 8:00 a.m. Friday morning.
- **CRATES** may be left overnight; however, Greater Kansas City Dog Training Club will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site. No dogs allowed overnight in the building. Indoor crating is available in a climate-controlled crating room on the south side of ASDS.
- **PARKING**: There is close parking, but please park conservatively. Please leave the area along the tree line on the south side of the parking lot for exhibitors crating out of their vehicles. Do not park on the grass on the south side of the driveway if it has been raining.
- **RV PARKING**:

- **Overnight RV parking** is not allowed at the trial site.
- **Daytime parking for small RVs will be limited to four.** Please contact Kim Krohn 816-830-0573 to reserve a space.
- There are RV parks in close proximity to the show site in the Jackson County Parks System at [Blue Springs Lake](#) and [Lake Jacomo](#). The Jackson County online registration page for campgrounds can be located by clicking [here](#). There are also private RV parks in Grain Valley, Oak Grove, and Odessa.
- **FOOD:** Please feel free to bring in outside food. There will be lunch and drinks available for workers. There are fast food and sit-down restaurants within close driving distance.
- **Exhibitors are responsible** for cleaning up after their dog(s). This includes all areas deemed by the AKC as part of the trial site. This includes but is not limited to anywhere on All Star Dog Sports property, anywhere on Harris Rentals property, all along the highway easement in front of those properties, any other adjacent property and its easement, and the grounds at any hotel/motel where you are staying. All these areas are considered part of the trial site. Any exhibitor failing to clean up after their dog(s) may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available.
- **VENDING:** There isn't space available for vendor tables but feel free to bring items to sell out of your vehicle or promotional information on your products. Please contact Kim Krohn 816-830-0573 with questions.
- **VOLUNTEERING:** Please volunteer to work. Workers will be supported with lunch and drinks if then turn in a lunch order form. Please sign up using the volunteer spreadsheet located on the secretary website [DoRightSecretary.com](#). or by clicking [here](#).
- **SPECTATORS:** Spectators will not be allowed to have their dogs with them. Dogs must be crated unless you are waiting to run, are running, or are exercising your dog(s). No other dogs will be allowed in the spectating area.
- **FAST CLASS:** Spectators are welcome during FAST class however no talking or visiting would be appreciated during the running of FAST class. Once FAST is complete, feel free to visit with fellow exhibitors and cheer them on for the remainder of the trial.

FOOD

- There are fast food restaurants and sit-down restaurants within 5 minutes of the show site.
- There will be lunch, snacks, and drinks available for workers. Please feel free to bring in outside food.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

- Please be aware that some navigation devices do not know the correct location for All Star Dog Sports. It is advised that you look at a map and find the location before trusting your phone or GPS.
- The site is **located** south of the city of Blue Springs on Highway 7, **just south of the intersection of Hwy 7 and Wyatt Rd, on the west side of Hwy 7.**
- If you are coming from the north (I-70), it is 4.8 miles south of the intersection of I-70 and Hwy 7 and immediately past Harris Rentals.
- If you are coming from the south, it is 1.4 miles north of the intersection of Hwy 7 and Colbern Rd. or 5.3 miles north of the intersection of Hwy 7 and Hwy 50 and north of the Storage Mart storage facility. Hwy 7 is divided by a median so it will be necessary to drive north of the site and make a U-turn at Wyatt Road.

ANNEX CRATING DIAGRAM

ASDS ANNEX CRATING RULES:

1. NO coolers/chairs/bags between crates
2. ALL crates/chairs on blue rubber tiles must be on mats/rugs
3. Chairs go in **aisles** in front of crates, NOT between crates
4. LESS THAN 6 inches between crates. Less than 4 preferred.
5. Saved spaces must be the size of the crate and have a note with person's name on it.
6. Use of tables over crates, or stacking crates, is encouraged. Unentered dogs should be stacked or crated together
